

# European Ladies' Amateur Championship.



The Competition will be played in accordance with the effective editions of the following publications:

- R&A Rules of Golf Limited, World Handicap System and Rules of Amateur Status
- EGA Conduct Guidelines and EGA Generic Rules and Regulations
- EGA Terms of Competition and EGA Hard Card

and the Additional Local Rules and Additional Terms of Competition below together with any Additional Local Rule and any Additional Term of Competition as approved by the Committee.

## Additional Local Rules

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty (Two strokes).

### 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18)

- Any white stake and white line connected with a white stake defines the boundary of the course.
- Internal out of bounds as indicated by white stakes to the left of hole 18.

### 2. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16)

- All drains not fully recovered are defined as French drains, see EGA Hard Card 3a(3).
- Staked trees are abnormal course conditions. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1.
- Immovable obstructions close to putting greens, EGA Hard Card 3b(5). Relief is available even if the ball lies in an area that is not cut to fairway height or less.
