

2020 European Ladies' Team Championship.



Practical information

Since the championship will be played under extraordinary circumstances due to the COVID-19 pandemic there are some measures that has to be attended to.

It is important we all contribute as much as we can to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

General

Any person who feels any symptoms of illness related to COVID-19 must immediately leave the golf club. Wash your hands often, use hand disinfectant, keep a distance of at least 2 m to the next person.

Transportation

All teams, except those arriving with their own cars, have been provided with a minibus from Sixt. There will be staff from Upsala GC to meet the teams at Stockholm Arlanda Airport and guide the teams to the car rental company. The driver of the minibus will have to present hers/his drivers' license at the Sixt desk. No credit card is needed, and insurance is paid in full. The car comes with full tank and can be returned empty.

Excess luggage

If there is not room for all luggage in the minibus the excess luggage will be transported to the hotel by the Upsala GC staff.

Location:

The GPS system in the minibus will guide you to the Elite Academia Hotel. The entrance is from Bäverns gränd, not from the bus terminal side! Parking has been reserved in the garage under the hotel. Hotel check-in will provide you with details on the parking.

Ceremonies

There is a restriction in Sweden of a maximum of 50 persons in a meeting or public gathering. Therefore, the ceremonies must be implemented with less than 50 persons.

Opening ceremony

Will be held on Tuesday 8 September and the captain and one (1) player will represent each country. Team members who are not representing their country at the ceremony cannot be on the premises and must leave the golf club. No spectators are allowed. Formal dinners after the ceremony are replaced by a 2-course lunch served after the practice round on a running basis.

Closing ceremony

Will be held on Saturday 12 September and the captain and one (1) player will represent each country except teams finishing 1-3 who will be represented by the captain and all four (4) team members. Team members who are not representing their country at the ceremony cannot be on the premises and must leave the golf club. No spectators are allowed. Formal dinners after the ceremony are replaced by a 3-course lunch served on a running basis as the

teams finish their final round. Team members of teams placed 1-4 will have the opportunity to shower and change in the locker rooms.

Photo session:

Team photographs in playing uniform will be taken on first tee before teeing off for the practice round. We ask all teams to present themselves on the first tee at least 10 minutes before teeing off.

Locker rooms and showers:

All teams will have 4 lockers available in the locker rooms. The locker rooms can only be used for storing things during the day and for using the restrooms. Showers and the changing of clothes before the opening and closing ceremony must be done at the hotel with one exception: the teams playing for the medals on the final day can use the locker rooms before the closing ceremony.

Driving range:

Each player will be provided with a card for 450 practice balls. If more practice balls are needed, players can fill up the card in the reception. We ask the captains to return the cards to the helpdesk after the tournament.

Restaurant:

The teams will have lunches in a tent adjacent to the main restaurant. Each team has its own table for the tournament. Each team will have an "open tab" during the tournament. These bills must be settled before the Closing Ceremony. During the tournament, the club house is open to members of Upsala GC playing the other courses.

Spectators:

Spectators are not allowed during the tournament. Team Captains, Team Advisors, non-playing Team members and officials from each nation are not considered spectators and are allowed onto the course.
